- Works collaboratively with all leaders.
- Builds relationships with the children, peers, parents, Kids Kamp Manager, Program and Events Coordinator and Community Services Director.
- Through supervision, ensures the safety and well-being of the program participants.
- Flexibility and willingness to engage the children as well as learn new behaviors.
- Assists with all facets of the Kids Kamp such as – recreational programs, snack times, lunches, and field trips, safety of children in both physical and emotional awareness.

- Identifies equipment and supplies needed for various activities.
