## *Committee of the Whole*

- The Committee received the Third Quarter Financial Report (Operations) – September 30, 2020 Staff Report and requested that more detail be provided regarding sources of funds for internal transfers on future quarterly reports.

## *Regular Council*

### Guest & Delegates

- Representatives from the Fort St. John Hospital Foundation requested that Council consider proclaiming November as “Be an Angel Month” and presented an overview of 2020 fundraising initiatives to support the Fort St. John Hospital and Peace Villa Care Facility.
- The Peace Crossing Historical Society presented an overview of potential ideas to recognize veterans as well as the consideration of a plot legend within the Peace Valley Cemetery. Council expressed their interest in the initiative and the Society advised that they will look into potential options and costs for Council’s consideration.

### Correspondence

- Council resolved to proclaim that November 2020 be declared as “Be an Angel” Month.
- Council resolved that Councillor Ponto be appointed as the Council representative to the BC Hydro Generate Opportunities (GO) Fund Committee for a two-year term.
- Council resolved that District facilities be available for use by the Ministry of Health for the purposes of holding Public Immunization Clinics, if requested.

### New Business

- Council resolved to endorse the grant application to the Northern Development Initiative Trust – Recreation Infrastructure fund for the Clubhouse Renovation Project at the Lone Wolf Golf Club.
