“Calling On Our Energy Experts”

The Northeast BC Resources Municipalities Coalition is hosting a working session on Wednesday, February 28, 2018 at the Pomeroy Hotel & Conference Centre from 10am to 4:30pm.

This is an opportunity for Northeast British Columbia to shine as leaders in ENERGY! The Province has committed to developing a new Energy Roadmap, but specific directives have not yet come down to the staff level. Our position as Energy Experts gives us a unique opportunity to have a working session and then to share our work with the Province of British Columbia.

This symposium will identify what we believe needs to be included and considered in the roadmap, to ensure optimal outcomes for the good of all British Columbians. By engaging the people who work directly in the energy sector, we will provide valuable insight to the development of the Province’s consultation process, and ultimately the final document; the Province of British Columbia’s Energy Roadmap.

The morning, with a message from the Ministry of Energy, Mines, and Petroleum Resources and a panel discussion about what an energy roadmap is, what needs to be included, who needs to be consulted, and what the optimal outcomes should be will lead into a keynote presentation by David Keane of the BC LNG Alliance.
