**PROPOSED GARBAGE COLLECTION & DISPOSAL BYLAW**



The District of Taylor is proposing to adopt a new Garbage Collection & Disposal Bylaw. The proposed bylaw outlines the garbage disposal requirements, the garbage collection system, container and collection requirements and prohibited materials. In addition, the District of Taylor is proposing to transition the garbage collection system to include automated garbage cart pickup. Details surrounding the new collection system are outlined in the proposed bylaw.

## How Do I Get More Information?

The public meeting will be held on Monday, May 15, 2017 at 5:00 PM in Council Chambers at the District Office, 10007 – 100 A Street. This public meeting will allow the public an opportunity to make presentations to Council or to present written submissions in regards to the proposed Garbage Collection & Disposal Bylaw. Written submissions will be accepted from the public until May 15, 2017.

A copy of the proposed Garbage Collection & Disposal Bylaw will be available for review from May 1-15, 2017. The bylaw will be available for review at the District Office, Monday through Friday during the office hours of 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM, excluding statutory holidays.
