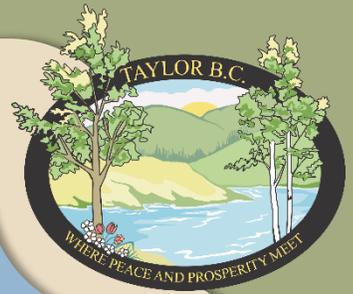


COUNCIL & COMMITTEE MEETING SUMMARIES

Public Works Committee

- The Committee recommended that Council suspend portions of the District's current Snow Removal & Ice Control Policy as it relates to driveway windrow removal procedures for the 2020-2021 winter season.

Protection Committee

- Staff prepared a Draft Maintenance of Property Bylaw (Nuisances & Unsightly Premise), which was distributed at the meeting, and requested the Committee's feedback with respect to the document before further work is conducted on the proposed bylaw.
- Staff advised the Committee that the Deputy Chief/Protective Services Specialist's resignation has been received.

Committee of the Whole

- The Committee reviewed the Draft Asset Management Policy and Draft Asset Management Strategy and provided general feedback on the document. The Committee agreed that a Council and Management workshop would be held to further discuss the proposed Asset Management Strategy.

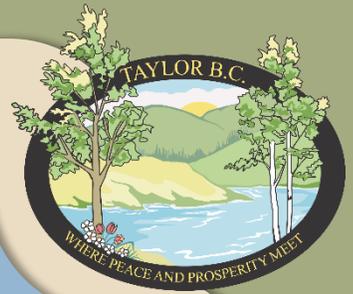

- Council discussed the Quail in Taylor correspondence received from Ashlee Kirshner and agreed not to proceed with a Bylaw amendment for the inclusion of quail within the community at this

time. It was noted that there will be another opportunity to discuss this topic further when the District commences public consultation on the Zoning Bylaw.

New Business

- Council resolved to endorse the proposed purchase of a new Data Server in 2020 and that the purchase be based on replacing the District's existing Data Server and migrating the email server to Outlook 365, a cloud based infrastructure, as per Option #2 outlined within the report.
- Council resolved that the Development Variance Permit Application 02-2020 be approved to permit a relaxation of the maximum front yard fence height, from the permitted 1.2 metres to 2.13 metres.

Annual General Meeting

- Council resolved to receive and accept the District of Taylor's 2019 Annual Report.
