


# COUNCIL & COMMITTEE MEETING SUMMARIES

## ***Recreation Committee***

- The Committee considered the Proposed Peace Island Park Pavilion Opening and requested staff to look into the opening of this facility for August 1, 2020.

## ***Committee of the Whole***

- The Committee considered the Proposed Revisions to the Peace Island Park Operational Safety Plan and requested that staff follow-up on the requirement on self-isolation procedures and guidelines for British Columbia before further consideration is given on the topic.
- Councilor Turnbull provided a verbal update on the Proposed Peace Island Park Pavilion Opening discussion held at the Recreation Committee Meeting earlier this day. The Committee requested that staff provide more information on rental considerations and guidelines, enforcement measures to ensure Provincial Guidelines are adhered to as well as feedback from the Park Caretakers regarding Pavilion opening considerations.

### Correspondence

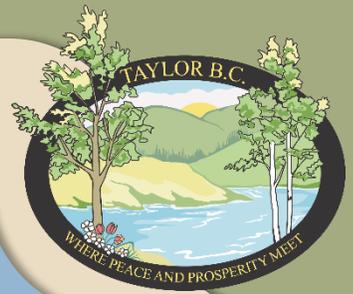
- Council requested that staff follow-up with the Fort St. John RCMP Detachment to express the District's interest in enhanced policing services within the community.

- Council resolved to authorize staff to work with Ms. Klassen to provide or find a suitable space for the proposed temporary fruit stand, subject to operational safety requirements being met.

- Council considered the proposed adoption of the Draft Snow & Ice Control Policy. It was noted that the Policy would be referred back to the Public Works Committee for consideration on the establishment of a service standard for snow and ice control in the municipality.
- Council adopted the Bylaw Enforcement Procedures Policy.
- Council resolved to send a letter to CN Rail to express safety concerns related to the Highway 97 Railway Crossing. Council and to also send a letter to the Local Manager for the Ministry of Transportation & Infrastructure requesting a temporary reduction in the speed limit on Highway 97 as a result of the safety concerns present at the Railway Crossing, until such a time as the intersection can be repaired and safety concerns addressed.

## Staff Reports

- Council directed staff to seek a legal opinion on the opening of the proposed Summer Kids Kamp Program. It was noted that Council would consider holding a Special Council Meeting to address the subject as it's nature is time sensitive.
